She becomes a servant to everyone in the house as she goes from room to room, waking them up as she sings the carols of her country and serves them hot coffee and rolls. Then a land that has slumbered in the dark shadows awakens as candles from nearby homes announce the beginning of a most joyous season.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Welcome to 2017. New calendars are on the wall. Dates are empty. Plans have yet to be made. Blank spaces have yet to be filled in. The new year beckons. We hope the New Year will be better than the last one. We make promises to ourselves to be better people. We make resolutions and dreams of improvements because we want this New Year to be a time of happiness and fulfillment. I wish you well on the accomplishment of your plans for 2017, whatever they may be.

There is something you may be certain of during the coming year. You may be certain that God will be with you. "Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the LORD your God goes with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you." (Deuteronomy 31:6) God will be with you through all of the good and bad times of 2017. God will be with you whether you stay in Othello the whole year or travel to exotic destinations. It seems to me we can do the same thing as a church. We are the body of Christ. We don't have anything to prove. We don't need to explain anything. We don't need to justify our existence. We can simply offer an invitation. What do you like about Pilgrim Lutheran? Come and see.
