Dear Pilgrims,

Can you hear it? I suppose it may be difficult to hear the approach of summer, but here it comes, ready or not! The weather is warmer, it has been weeks since we had a frost, the overnight temperatures are well above freezing, the flowers are blooming, and even the cherries are getting ripe for harvest already. There is something in the way the birds chirp so early in the morning that tells me summer is quickly approaching, and many people are feeling the travel bug, getting itchy for exploring other places.

It is good to get out there and explore. It is good to see different sights and check things off of your bucket list. It is good to visit people and places that you cannot see every day. It seems like Paul's love of travel was insatiable, but there was this one time when the Holy Spirit told Paul and his travel companions not to go to Asia, but instead go to Macedonia. It was then that Paul met Lydia, who helped him form the church in Philippi. (See Acts 12-16)

You see, sometimes God sends us on missions we do not expect. Sometimes, even when we think we have our whole trip meticulously planned, the Holy Spirit sends us off in a new direction. Take my advice, enjoy your trip, obey all traffic laws, and when the Holy Spirit sends you off in a direction where you did not plan to go, simply say, "Yes, Lord" and enjoy the ride.
