April Message from our Pastor

Dear Pilgrims,

I have known of churches in the past where, once Easter was over, the congregation kind of evaporated until the beginning of the next program year in September. I hope that doesn't happen this year. After all, Easter was in March! That leaves a lot of time before summer for some fun church events. Personally, I hope you will make time for church this month, because there are a couple of events I think you will particularly enjoy.

Coming up on April 28th, our Assistant to the Bishop, Pastor Phil Misner, will be with us. He has offered to preach and preside over worship, and I know he has experience doing that, because he served in Colfax for a long time before being called to the synod office. He happens to be a seminary classmate of mine, so I know he got a good seminary education.
