#### **Newsletter Article for June 2025**

Dear Pilgrims,

Here is the announcement I made at the end of worship on May 25th:

"I have a personal announcement to make. Anna and I have been discussing this for several months, and we have decided to retire this summer. We will continue to work with you until the end of July, but after the last Sunday of July, we will be moving to the Portland, Oregon area.

I want you all to know that the last nine years have been wonderful for us. This congregation has walked with us through a lot, from my pulmonary embolism and open-heart surgery in 2018, to my car accident in 2023, and through many joyful events in between. You all will be remembered fondly by us, and we are grateful for the time we have spent together.

But I have spent many hours in prayer, and in discussions with Anna and my sons, and even our financial advisor, and we honestly feel that the Holy Spirit is guiding us in a new direction. We ask that you understand that we love you all dearly, and we know that Jesus has guided our time together, from the chance meeting at a gas station in North Dakota, all the way to this moment.

In the next two months, Pastor Phil Misner, the Associate to the Bishop, will be working with the church council and with me to prepare us for a smooth transition. I believe the Holy Spirit has a bright future planned for this congregation, and that future will benefit from new leadership. So, what I am asking for today is your understanding, your prayers, and your commitment to this church to work through this transition, help wherever you are able, and be open to new possibilities. I hope you will be understanding that, at the age of 66, I am feeling the call to be with my relatives, but we will both carry the love of Pilgrim Lutheran wherever we go. Thank you and may God's peace be with you."

There are many reasons for retiring now, and I can give you more details if you wish, but I am committed to making sure the transition to new leadership is smooth over the next two months, and Pastor Phil Misner is also working on this already, so rest assured, Pilgrim Lutheran Church will continue to function well, for now and for many years to come.
